#### Race Day Program Key



#### **Steeplechase Horses**

- All steeplechasers are Thoroughbreds whose lineage must be proven with official Jockey Club registration papers. Horses can begin steeplechase careers at age three.
- · Most steeplechasers competed or still compete on the flat. The ideal steeplechaser has speed, stamina, smarts and enough athletic ability to run and jump at the same time. In general, steeplechase horses are larger than their flat counterparts, but size is not a rule. Big horses tend to have more stamina, which is important. Also, horses trained for steeplechasing develop larger muscles across their backs - to help with the jumping.
- The best jumpers clear the fences in one long stride like a human hurdler jumps in track and field events.
- Almost all steeplechase trainers are based on private farms, where horses enjoy the outdoors while also exercising and working toward their next racing date.
- It is not unusual to see steeplechase horses compete until age 10 and beyond. At age 13, Ninepins won a Grade I stakes at Saratoga in 2000.
- Steeplechase horses typically run six to 10 times in a year. The season features no racing in January and February, plus a light summer schedule - assuring horses of lengthy vacations. Most "downtime" is spent outdoors in fields. A steeplechase horse in the off-season is often dirty, hairy - and happy.
- · After their steeplechase careers end, horses often become fox hunters, show horses or simply pleasure rides for their owners or trainers. Hall of Famers Flatterer and Zaccio found "second lives" as a dressage horse and a fox hunter, respectively.

- The Pony Races, Junior Race, and other unsanctioned races will be run under the rules of the Genesee Valley Hunt Race Committee.
- The Committee reserves the right to change, modify, postpone or eliminate any scheduled race, and the decision of the Committee will be final.
- The Committee reserves the right, and without notice, to refuse any entry.
- 5. The Genesee Valley Hunt, Inc., its members or officers and/ or agents of the owners of the land on which these events are held, individually or severally, will not be responsible for any property damage or personal injury to spectators, owners, riders or their agents, employees or friends, arising out of these events.
- Waivers must be signed by owners/trainers and riders. The waiver is found with entry form and also online at www. GVHRaces.com. Payment must be sent with entry or made online by following link at www.GVHRaces.com
- 7. A horse may start in only one race.
- 8. The Genesee Valley Hunt and its officials take no cognizance of betting or wagering of any sort.
- Riders will be required to attest that they have walked the course prior to post time.
- 10. Objections to the entry of any horse or rider must be lodged with the Racing Secretary before horses leave the paddock for the race.
- 11. No sex or other allowances may be claimed for any of these races, unless otherwise stated.
- 12. Equipment and condition of horses must be approved by the Paddock Judge on race day. A flat saddle is required for all races, except for entries in the Stockhorse Sprint.
- 13. For all races safety helmet with harness must be worn. For jumping races, safety vests are required.



#### WHAT'S GOING ON?

Racing Color - Jockeys wear different brightly colored silks for the purpose of identification at a distance by observers, owners, trainers, and especially the officials.

The Paddock - The paddock is a fenced in enclosure for the race entries. The trainer or authorized representative must saddle his own entry. The rider must weigh in correctly before mounting. A traditional cry of "Riders up!" can be heard minutes before race

Outriders, dressed in hunting attire, escort the entire group of entries from the paddock to the race course. Outriders remain posted around the course in case assistance is needed.

Some horses have a lead pony, or private escort, from the paddock. Being led by another, quieter horse, tends to calm a nervous or rowdy entry.

The Start - Unlike racing at the track, entries at these races do not start from a starting gate. Instead, horses circle and gain momentum as they head for the starting point where they are lined up. If the horses are relatively equal when they reach the start, the race begins. If the group is uneven, the starter may call the entries back for another start.

The Race - The term flat race or on the turf means the horse does not jump any obstacles. Over timber means horses jump fixed obstacles of three or more feet.

The distance of each race is indicated in the program. One trip around constitutes approximately one mile and one half.

If a horse runs out or refuses an obstacle, it may continue the race by turning back and jumping the refused obstacle. The same applies for going off course. The horse must return to the proper point, or it will be disqualified.

The Officials - Judges in the stand determine the official order of finishing entries. Race timers are also in the stand, as well as the stewards.

The Steward is the highest presiding official on the race grounds. If a foul is claimed during a race, he presides over the inquiry.

Reasons for claiming fouls usually involve physical interference with an entry.



## James C. Creagan 1946-2021

Jim had the rare distinction of being awarded his colors in the field by MFH Martha D. Wadsworth, at least partially because he was the only field member to follow her up a nearly vertical bank on a memorable hunt at McQueen's Switch. Another factor may have been that his horse, C.K., jumped over Martha when she was knocked off her horse at speed by a low branch next to corn; she always said she appreciated not being stepped on.

Jim came to riding and hunting late in life but embraced the sport with vigor. He understood the nuances of hunting and as a field member was often asked to assist the huntsman in various small ways.

Jim and several assistants set up the grounds for the GVH Races for

a decade or more. Two of his favorite helpers for tying up snow fence were Sally Wood and Martha D. Wadsworth. Many who rode in the hunt field with Jim did not know that he was a highly decorated Vietnam helicopter pilot. They did know, however, that he was an avid foxhunter, a tireless and reliable

volunteer, and an innovative problem solver whose quick wit made any encounter with him a pleasure.





There are 35 1/2 couple of cross-bred foxhounds in the kennels today, whose bloodlines go back to a pack bred by Harry Andrews, huntsman under Winthrop Chanler, Ernest Woodward, and James S. Wadsworth. New blood has since been added, locally from hounds bred by Lewis Bailey and Irvin Baird and by sending bitches to other hunts for breeding. In recent years, the Brandywine and the Midland hunts in particular have added strength to the pack. A few years ago, we received a large draft of Randy Waterman's famous American and Crossbred Piedmont hounds. These very fast, accurate and biddable hounds hunted fox for him in Virginia, and then coyote very successfully in Alabama and have been a great addition to our pack.

In 2021 our hounds finished 3rd in the Millbrook Performance Trial, with our young hound Winter '20 finishing 3rd overall. Winter was also chosen as the Huntsman's Choice, the hound he would most like to take home. Our pack is really something to be proud of.
